General Brown joined Aurora's Board of Directors in 2007.

General Brown is the President of Tier 4 Consulting LLC. Prior to Tier 4 Consulting, General Brown served 40 years in the United States Army (retiring on September 1, 2007). As a general officer, he served as Assistant Division Commander (Maneuver), 1st Infantry Division (The Big Red One), Fort Riley, KS and then returned to Special Operations as the Director of Plans, Policy and Strategic assessments at U.S. Special Operations Command, MacDill AFB, FL. General Brown then assumed command of Joint Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg, NC from 1998 to 2000 and later U. S. Army Special Operations Command, Fort Bragg, NC from 2000 to 2002. General Brown then commanded the United States Special Operations Command from 2003 to 2007.

General Brown was the first member of the Army's Aviation Branch to be promoted to the rank of four-star General and to serve as a Combatant Commander. General Brown's awards and decorations include the Distinguished Service Medal, the Legion of Merit, the Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star Medal and the Air Medal with "V" Device. He also earned the Special Forces Tab, Master Army Aviator Badge, Military Free Fall Parachutist Badge and the Air Assault Badge. He is a recipient of the Ellis Island Medal of Honor and was selected by the Congressional Medal of Honor Society as their Patriot of the Year for 2007.

He is a member of the Army Aviation Hall of Fame.

General Brown received his Bachelor of Arts degree in History from Cameron University and his Masters of Business Administration degree from Webster University. Also, General Brown is a graduate of the Harvard Executive Education Program's National and International Security Managers Course.
